Boast in this God based on this Script

How should we boast against Death?

“Oh death where is your sting, O grave where is your victory?”

Christ is the source of the water of life.

3. What is the difference between boasting and boasting in God? What is the big difference between 114:1-4 and 114:5-8? Talk about when a believer might use the answers to the questions in Romans 8:31-39 to boast in God.
4. What stuck out to you from the sermon Sunday?
5. What themes do you find helpful or interesting?
6. What sin did the Holy Spirit convict you of in this sermon?
7. How were you encouraged by this passage?
8. How does this passage connect to or inform our understanding of the gospel?
