Jesus' Internal Trial and Betrayal

You can't understand Golgotha without Gethsemane

"Remove this cup from me"-the wine of God's wrath

In the garden, Jesus goes from reluctance to face the wrath of God to readiness to fulfill the word of God.

In God's hands there were a cup and a sword— he would drink the cup of God's wrath & the sword of God's justice and judgment would strike him.

Jesus' Initial Trial and Denial

Jesus displays both composure and courage, while Peter is doing the opposite.

There are two characteristics that can't coexist in a disciple of Jesus: prideful & faithful.
