Mark 14:1-31 p.850

Christianity is nothing more and nothing less than the gospel and its implications.

An Anointing for Jesus' death

Jesus sees this extravagant act as an anointing of his body beforehand for burial.

An Analogy of Jesus' death

The Passover Lamb was on the table and at the table.

An Abandonment at Jesus' death

One would betray Jesus and the others would fall away from Jesus.
