Sermon Study Guide

1. What evidences of grace have you seen since we last met?
2. How would you define God's providence, based on the message, and what is the promise believers have about "all things" that affect them? (8:28)
3. What does "he called" mean in 8:30? Some who love God do not have a clear memory of the specific time this call produced faith in them, but if you do, share about your coming to faith.
4. What stuck out to you from the sermon Sunday?
5. What themes do you find helpful or interesting?
6. What sin did the Holy Spirit convict you of in this sermon?
7. How were you encouraged by this passage?
8. How does this passage connect to or inform our understanding of the gospel?
