Sermon Study Guide

1. What evidences of grace have you seen since we last met?
2. Talk about this "You can't reflect long on gospel doctrine and not erupt in sincere worship as a true believer." How can someone have gospel doctrine or emotional worship and not be saved?
3. Look at 11:34-35 and discuss how these questions show us that God is never dependent on us.
4. What stuck out to you from the sermon Sunday?
5. What themes do you find helpful or interesting?
6. What sin did the Holy Spirit convict you of in this sermon?
7. How were you encouraged by this passage?
8. How does this passage connect to or inform our understanding of the gospel?
