Sermon Study Guide

1. What evidences of grace have you seen since we last met?
2. Discuss what is said in the first three and last three verses of Psalm 110 about Jesus as Invincible King. Think of people you know who don't know Christ and pause to pray for them to trust in Christ's sacrifice and submit to him as Lord.
3. Look at Psalm 110:4. What are some ways Hebrews 7 compares Jesus with Melchizedek and contrasts Jesus to other priests? How does this encourage you?
4. What stuck out to you from the sermon Sunday?
5. What themes do you find helpful or interesting?
6. What sin did the Holy Spirit convict you of in this sermon?
7. How were you encouraged by this passage?
8. How does this passage connect to or inform our understanding of the gospel?
