**Specific Duties for Titus**

• **What is said about Titus in the New Testament?**

Titus was evidently a capable and credible spiritual leader.

• **What is said to Titus in this text?**

Show (with your works)

...so others become zealous for good works.

Tell (with your words)

...having the right

motive

manner

• **What is said about the purpose of Titus, and the others, doing these things?**

...so that the gospel isn't unattractive but is attractive

## Sermon Study Guide

(Reminder: The purpose of the questions is to explore the text and themes of the sermon. **Do not feel a need to go through all of the questions, but try to discuss/study some in each category.** The goal is to stimulate discussion/reflection and transformation related to the sermon text and themes.)

1. What evidences of grace have you seen since we last met?
2. Read the phrases at the end of Titus 2:5, 8, 10, that begin with "so that...". Talk about the purpose of God's people, like Titus, living like they are instructed in 2:1-10.
3. Titus was to "show himself in all respect to be a model of good works" because God intends for his people to be "zealous for good works". Look at Titus 2:14 and talk about how this is a reason and motivation for gospel redemption.
4. What stuck out to you from the sermon Sunday?
5. What themes do you find helpful or interesting?
6. What sin did the Holy Spirit convict you of in this sermon?
7. How were you encouraged by this passage?
8. How does this passage connect to or inform our understanding of the gospel?
