Insist On The Need For The Gospel

- We Are Both Perpetrators & Victims Of Sin

Insist On The Source Of The Gospel

- The Triune God: Father, Spirit, Son

Insist On The Grounds Of The Gospel

- Not By Our Works
- But By God's Goodness, Love, Kindness, Mercy, & Grace

Insist In The Means Of The Gospel

- He Saved Us: Washed, Regenerated, Renewed, & Justified

Insist On The Goal Of The Gospel

- Heirs, Hope, Eternal Life

Insist On The Evidence Of The Gospel

- Careful devotion of the whole self to good works
- Excellent and profitable for yourself and others
