## Sermon Study Guide

2. What is and isn't being promised in Psalm 125:1-2? How does Luke 21:16-19 relate to this promise. Also look at Romans 8:31-39.
3. How does Ps. 125:3 point to the eternal, earthly reign of Christ? Notice how it is described in Rev. 21:1-8. What is the relationship between being good and receiving good, for those who trust in the Lord?
4. What stuck out to you from the sermon Sunday?
5. What themes do you find helpful or interesting?
6. What sin did the Holy Spirit convict you of in this sermon?
7. How were you encouraged by this passage?
8. How does this passage connect to or inform our understanding of the gospel?
