Judgement Day

Acts 24

**Judgment Day: for Paul before the Governor**

The Way is not a forsaking, but a fulfilling of the Hebrew Scriptures.

*Felix didn't render a verdict in Paul's case.*

**Judgment Day: for All at the Resurrection**

Resurrection day will be Judgment day.

**For Paul**— those who do put faith in Christ.

“...in the gospel...you get the verdict before the performance.”

**For Felix**—those who don't put faith in Christ.

*Felix didn't render a verdict on Paul's Christ.*

Today, if you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts.

## Sermon Study Guide

(Reminder: The purpose of the questions is to explore the text and themes of the sermon. **Do not feel a need to go through all of the questions, but try to discuss/study some in each category.** The goal is to stimulate discussion/reflection and transformation related to the sermon text and themes.)

1. What evidences of grace have you seen since we last met?
2. What stuck out to you from the sermon Sunday?
3. Why is it dangerous to procrastinate in regard to turning from sin and trusting in Christ for salvation? How does Felix illustrate this?
4. Look at 24:15, 21, 25. What can we put together and learn from these references about judgment day and resurrection day?
5. Was Paul's seriousness about having a clear conscience motivated by the desire to earn a favorable verdict, or motivated by knowing he had already received this kind of verdict through faith? (see Rom. 5:1 and 8:1)
6. What sin did the Holy Spirit convict you of in this sermon?
7. How were you encouraged by this passage?
8. How does this passage connect to or inform our understanding of the gospel?
