The structure and furnishings of the Old Covenant Tabernacle (1-5)

First section– the Holy Place

Second section– The Most Holy Place

The purification and offerings of the Old Covenant Priesthood (6-10)

They couldn't come inside.

(They had to stay on the outside.)

They weren't cleansed inside.

(They were only sanctified on the outside.)
