**Because Jesus has appeared as the final, all-sufficient sacrifice for sin,
he will appear again as our returning Savior.**

1. Jesus the final, all-sufficient sacrifice (23-26)

The better sacrifice provides a better purification

The better sacrifice need never be repeated or supplemented

2. Jesus the returning Savior (27-28)

Those who trust in the better sacrifice need no longer
fear death or judgment.

Sermon Study Guide

1. What evidences of grace have you seen since we last met?

4. In Hebrews 9:26, where Jesus is described as appearing "at the end of the ages to put away sin." Look up Hebrews 1:21, 1 Corinthians 10:11, and Galatians 4:4. How do these verses help us to rightly place ourselves in God's great story of redemption?
5. How does Christ's first coming help you endure in the faith? How does the promise of his second coming help you endure?
6. What has the Holy Spirit convict you of in this sermon?
7. How were you encouraged by this passage?
8. How does this passage connect to or inform our understanding of the gospel?
