The Triumphant Procession of God

Psalm 68 (Pg. 481)

The God of Triumph (1-6)

Exult in His might and triumph, but also in His mercy and tenderness!

The Triumph of God [for his people] (7-35)

Under Moses (7-14)

Under David (15-35)

In Christ (18a, 1, 20b, 11b)

Psalm 68:18 is at the center of this Psalm because what it says is central and it is fulfilled in Christ.

Sermon Study Guide

(Reminder: The purpose of the questions is to explore the text and themes of the sermon. **Do not feel a need to go through all of the questions.**

The goal is to stimulate discussion/reflection and transformation related to the sermon text and themes.)

1. What evidences of grace have you seen since we last met?
2. What stuck out to you from the sermon Sunday?
3. How do the triumphs of God under Moses and David foreshadow God's triumphs in Christ?
4. How do these verses point to Christ: 68:1; 68:18a; 68:11b & 68:20b? Talk about Eph. 4:8.
5. What has the Holy Spirit convicted you of in this sermon?
6. How were you encouraged by this passage?
7. How does this passage connect to or inform our understanding of the gospel?
