1 Peter 2:11-12 (p.1015) Truth #1 for the Christian: I am a sojourner and exile in this world (vs 11) A. This world isn't our home. B. Comfort is not our goal. C. God's mission is our mandate. Therefore, it is critical that we <u>discern</u> what is at stake. Truth # 2 for the Christian: I am a representative of Christ to this world (vs 12) Recognize what is <u>available</u> to us. Questions to ask when getting a spiritual game plan in place: 1. Where is the battle fought? 2. What are my weaknesses and where am I susceptible?

3. What weapons are available to me?

4. Who should be in this battle with me?

5. What should my primary focus be fixed on?
