## Sermon Study Guide

(Reminder: The purpose of the questions is to explore the text and themes of the sermon. **Do not feel a need to go through all of the questions.**

The goal is to stimulate discussion/reflection and transformation related to the sermon text and themes.)

1. Describe Peter's teaching on God's character and patience, Jesus' unique suffering and exaltation, and the Spirit's new birth (vv. 18-20).
2. Discuss how baptism is an appeal to God for a good conscience (v. 21).
3. What does it mean that Jesus has subjected angels, authorities, and powers (v. 22)?
4. Given that Jesus' example provides us with the promise of exaltation in heaven, what obligation does this passage place on the Christian? What particular way is God you to act?
5. What implications does this passage hold for a non-believer?
