## Sermon Study Guide

**Life Group Questions adapted from John Stott's commentary on 2 Timothy in The Bible Speaks Today series.**

1. What are the 'last days' (2 Timothy 3:1)? What is it about them that Timothy needs to know? How is this relevant to us today?
2. How is it possible to be religious and yet still demonstrate the characteristics listed in 2 Timothy 3:2-4?
3. Why is it important that Paul says to Timothy in 3:10-11: "You... have followed my teaching, my conduct," etc? How does this relate to the false teachers (and those who follow them) described in the first half of the chapter?
