

## Sermon Study Guide

(Reminder: The purpose of the questions is to explore the text and themes of the sermon. **Do not feel a need to go through all of the questions.**

The goal is to stimulate discussion/reflection and transformation related to the sermon text and themes.)

**Take time to consider the following statements Jesus made, then be prepared to discuss a few of them by answering the question: “What does Jesus mean when He said....?”**

1. "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." (Jn. 8:12). "If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." (Jn. 8:31-32). "Truly, truly, I say to you, if anyone keeps my word, he will never see death." (Jn. 8:51)

2. "You are from below; I am from above. You are of this world; I am not of this world. I told you that you would die in your sins, for unless you believe that I am he you will die in your sins." (Jn. 8:23-24). "Truly, truly, I say to you, everyone who practices sin is a slave to sin." (Jn. 8:34)

3. "When you have lifted up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am he, and that I do nothing on my own authority, but speak just as the Father taught me. And he who sent me is with me. He has not left me alone, for I always do the things that are pleasing to him." (Jn. 8:28-29)? "Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I am." (Jn. 8:58)
