## **Sermon Study Guide**

(Reminder: The purpose of the questions is to explore the text and themes of the sermon. **Do not feel a need to go through all of the questions.**The goal is to stimulate discussion/reflection and transformation related to the sermon text and themes.)

- 1. While washing the disciples' feet, Jesus made a theological statement (vv. 7-10) then called them to apply that truth (vv. 12b-17). Discuss Jesus' theological truth and how it ought to shape our practical obedience.
- 2. Observe Jesus' interactions with Judas, Peter, and the other disciples in chapter 13. What do we learn about our Savior and how He builds Christian community.
- 3. Alone with His disciples Jesus testified that one of them would betray Him (21-27), and yet even this would result in the glory of the Father and Son (31-32). What does this teach us about God's control over evil?
- 4. Sandwiched between Jesus' announcement of Judas' betrayal and Peter's denial, He gave a new commandment to His disciples: "you are to love one another; just as I have loved you" (34, cf. 13:1). Why did Jesus give this new commandment here? How did Jesus love the disciples, how has Jesus loved us?
