Sermon Study Guide

(Reminder: The purpose of the questions is to explore the text and themes of the sermon. **Do not feel a need to go through all of the questions.**The goal is to stimulate discussion/reflection and transformation related to the sermon text and themes.)

- 1. Reflect on and discuss the following questions on discipleship from John 12:24-26: Why is the price of discipleship so high / why is self-denial so hard? Encourage one another by sharing examples of what following Jesus looks like in your life? How should Jesus' promises motivate us (see v. 26)?
- 2. What does Jesus mean when He says He "will be lifted up" (12:32)? Look at John 12:27-36 and list the repercussions from Jesus being "lifted up".
- 3. What explanation does John give his readers for the lack of faith in spite of Jesus' many signs (12:37-43)?
- 4. John places the content of 12:44-50 here as Jesus' last public teaching before His death, in a real sense John uses this as Jesus' public farewell address. So, what we learn about the heart of Christ for sinners? What do we learn about the origins/authority of Jesus' ministry? What warnings does Jesus provide? How then should we respond?
