Sermon Study Guide

(Reminder: The purpose of the questions is to explore the text and themes of the sermon. **Do not feel a need to go through all of the questions.**

The goal is to stimulate discussion/reflection and transformation related to the sermon text and themes.)

1. Throughout John's gospel there's an emphasis on Jesus' death by crucifixion (Jn. 3:14; 8:28; 12:32; 18:32; 19:6). Is it the way or the prophecy that is so important? What does this reveal to us about Jesus?
2. Our passage speaks of Jesus' kingship and authority. How is Jesus' reign and rule unlike any other king? (See 18:36-37 for force and 19:11, 15-16 for authority and justice)
3. Jesus said His purpose for being born and coming into the world was to bear witness to the truth. What truth is Jesus a witness to?
4. If Jesus has purpose before He is born and before He came into the world, what does this reveal to us about His pre-existence (Jn 1:1-4; 8:58)?
