- 1. What aspects of Jesus' kingship are seen in this passage?
- 2. What does Jesus mean by "It is finished" (v. 30)? Why is this truth so important?
- 3. Why is it important to John that his reader see the fulfillment of OT passages? (vv. 23-24 see Ps. 22:18; vv. 28-29 see Ps. 69:21; vs. 36 see Ex. 12:46; Num. 9:12; Ps. 34:20; vs. 37 see Zech. 12:10). What purpose do these fulfillments serve in making John's argument that we should believe Jesus is God's Savior (35)?
- 4. Why is the false gospel of our day (prosperity / health & wealth) inadequate to teach the atonement?
- 5. What impact does seeing the hypocrisy of religious men have on you (18:28, 31, 40: 19:12, 15, 31)?
- 6. Why is it important to John that his reader understand that Jesus was dead?
