## Sermon Study Guide

The goal is to stimulate discussion/reflection and transformation related to the sermon text and themes.)

1. List some ways God has spoken in the past. What of these do you find the most surprising? What of these do you find the most compelling?
2. In our study on Sunday morning of Hebrews 1:1-3, we surveyed just a few ways that 'God has spoken in his Son.' List these, and as many others as you can. Which of these do you find stirs your heart as you ponder it?
3. Obviously, there were many who rejected God's message in Jesus, and still to this day. What do you think is/are the difference(s) between those who hear and those who don't?
4. We worship a God who goes to great lengths to reveal himself to us! The unstated invitation of this God who speaks is to listen. List what you believe to be the primary hurdles that keep people from listening, people in general, and you specifically. What would you like help with in listening better?
