- 3. Why did God pursue Jonah (v. 4)? Why does God pursue us? Meditate on Ephesians 2:1-7
- 4. Look at v. 5-15 and consider the apathy of Jonah and the efforts of the sailors. Where might you be ignoring or resisting God's pursuit of you?
- 5. Chapter 1 reveals that God's word, work, and will always wins. What takeaways do you see in v. 16-17?
